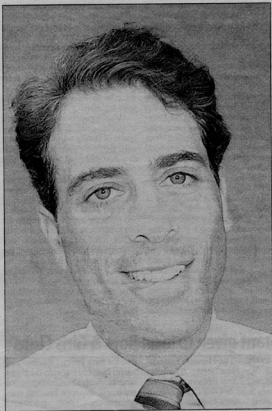

# David Mazie named to top ten attorney list



### DAVID MAZIE

Trial attorney David Mazie, a Wayne native, has been named to the "Ten Leaders of Civil Trial & Personal Injury Law of Northern New Jersey." The designation was based on a ballot by the group's existing members. The original survey by Digital Press International of Fort Lee was conducted in 2003.

Mazie, a partner at the firm Nagel Rice & Mazie, located in Roseland, has won settlements and verdicts totaling \$150 million over the last three years, including the largest personal injury award ever by a New Jersey jury. In that case, Mazie represented the family of a young girl paralyzed in a serious car accident, caused by a drunk driver returning from a New York Giants football game. One of the defendants, Aramark Corp., was a concessionaire at Giants Stadium; the company was held liable in that case. The January 2005 award of more than

\$130 million is the largest liquor liability award in U.S. legal history.

In the last year Mazie was also voted the state's top lawyer by New Jersey Monthly Magazine and was named to Best Lawyers in America 2005. He is a graduate of Rutgers University and George Washington University School of Law. Still in his early 40s, Mazie is widely regarded as an aggressive, creative trial attorney according to his Ten Leaders profile.

Mazie lives with his family in Morris County.
